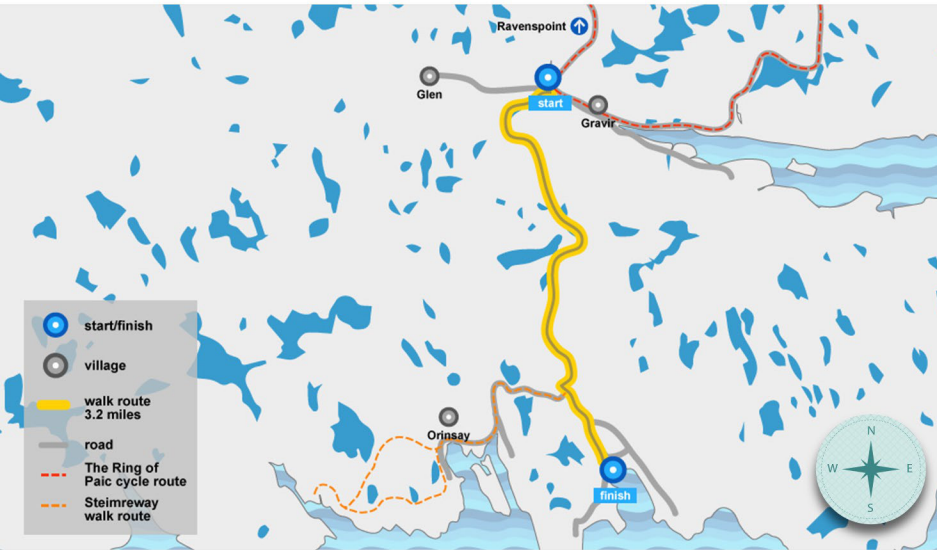




Cycling

“Shiant view”



“Stunning views of the Shiant Islands.”

Length: 6.6 miles

Time: 1 hour

Difficulty: Medium

Mostly gentle hills with a couple of steeper sections.

This leaflet is information only. Please ensure you have the experience to undertake these rides safely.

This ride offers great views of the Shiant Islands, which are home to huge colonies of seabirds. It can be added to the ‘Ring of Paic’ (adding 3.3 miles each way), or ridden directly from Ravenspoint (8 miles each way).

Just head East from Ravenspoint to Gravir, and follow the signs to Lemreway. There’s a great viewpoint before you drop into the village. There’s another great view from the bay at Orinsay, which is a short detour, and well worth the extra effort.

Orinsay is also the start point for the walk to the abandoned village of Steimreway, and combining the two makes for a great day out! Find out more about the unique history of this remarkable settlement at Ravenspoint.

The Shiant Islands have been owned by the Nicholson family for over 50 years. Adam Nicholson’s book, ‘Sea Room’, available at Ravenspoint, tells the story of these remote islands.
